



**PREVENTION AND EARLY DETECTION PROGRAMMES
(ONCOLOGICAL SCREENING)
INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL
DATA**

art. 13 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 – GDPR

By this note, the Local Health Unit provides the most important information concerning the processing of personal data within the activities of Prevention and Early Detection programmes (oncological screening), in compliance with the applicable regulations regarding privacy.

The general privacy policy and any additional information on the processing of personal data by the Local Health Unit (USL) of Modena is available on the institutional website www.ausl.mo.it/privacy.

LEGAL BASIS AND PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data requested are necessary to provide and manage the administrative activities and are used by the staff of the Screening services expressly authorised, subject to professional secrecy and in compliance with the rules on Privacy.

As required by law, the processing of personal data and the data related to health shall be made by USL of Modena **without requiring the consent** of the person concerned.

We report that the Local Unit sends a letter of invitation and a reminder letter to accede through the screening programme at the electronic health records (for the ones who activated it), the general medical practitioner (MMG) and by ordinary mail sent to the person's home.

TO WHOM THE DATA MAY BE DISCLOSED WITH

The personal data can be communicated only to the subjects who intervene in the screening program, in correspondence to their respective and specific jurisdiction.

Furthermore, the aggregated data are sent to the Region for the administrative and accounting procedures.

METHODS OF PROCESSING AND DATA RETENTION PERIOD

The personal data provided are processed with the aid of computerised and/or paper means and are protected in order to guarantee their safety, their confidentiality and a limit access to authorized personnel only. The data shall be kept only for such time as may be required to achieve the purposes for which they were supplied.

THE SUBJECT'S RIGHTS

The subject is entitled to access his personal data and may request amendments if data are incorrect or incomplete. Furthermore, in the situations provided by law, the person may also ask the control of use of the data and may naturally exercise his right to object to the gathering and processing of the data. For that purpose, he may submit an application to the Data Protection Office of the Unit by writing to dpo@ausl.mo.it

On the above assumptions, he may also appeal with a complaint to the Authority for the protection of personal data, in accordance with the procedures established.
