Peter Thanks, but I'm here with some visitors. See you.





Peter Thank you.



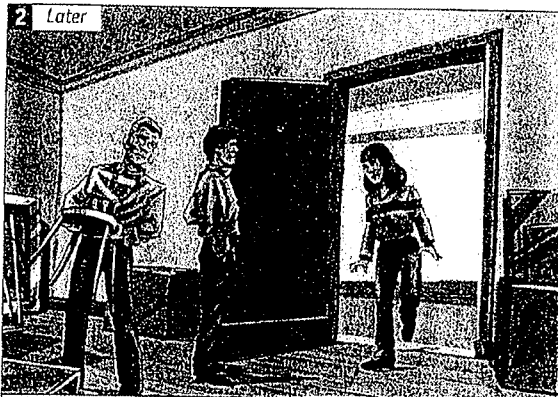
